- a) City Career Fair Virtual Video (VV) Diversity Employment Day; Oakland, Sept. 10, 2021. This fair, which KTSF has sponsored in previous years, provides access to candidates from multicultural and diverse communities. This year, the candidates were from around the Bay Area and in particular the city of Oakland with its very rich and wide diversity of applicants. The trade provided by KTSF included promos about the fair in English, Cantonese and Mandarin.
- b) Foothill College Fall Career Fair Dec. 1, 2021
- c) Diablo Valley College Career Fair (in person); Pleasant Hill, March 23, 2022. This event was open to current DVC students, alumni, and the community at large and reaching a wide diversity of job seekers. As a sponsor, KTSF included promos about the fair on our air, website and social media in English, Cantonese and Mandarin.
- d) Annual Diversity Employment Day Career Fair; In-person; San Francisco April 6, 2022. Once again, KTSF was a major sponsor for this fair which provides access to candidates from multicultural and diverse communities. As a sponsor, KTSF had promos on air, website and on social media in Chinese and English. And, a large number of applicants at the career fair said they learned about the event through KTSF. We received resumes that we may not have known about otherwise and we actually hired one of the applicants the next day! Established training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions.

- a) Provided digital video sales training for the sales, promotions and programming departments; Aug. 25, 2021. Staff acquired skills and confidence in selling KTSF's digital video opportunities on Vu-It app along with TV and Digital Video.
- b) Provided CPR/AED training by the American Red Cross to six staff who work various shifts and days. KTSF feels these employees have a skill that upper management at future job opportunities would appreciate. Sept. 9, 2021
- c) As of Aug. 4, 2021, Cybersecurity Training Modules were required for all existing and newlyhired staff. The training consisted of longer and shorter formats on an ongoing basis. This included Phishing tests which helped staff spot "bad actors." Having this training is a skill that employees can include as an asset on future career objectives.
- d) Provided three KTSF engineers additional training through the Society of Broadcast Engineers (SBE) which was conducted during the first week in June 2022 and reviewed by engineering staff on July 7, 2022. The webinars included updated requirements for Broadcast Engineers and is an investment towards career development due to enhanced level of skills.

e) July 6, 2022. Our most experienced journalists provided training of new reporters to help sharpen their skills in filming and video editing. This included capturing and making good use of audio (i.e. up sound, nat sound,) filming from different angles, different framing, close ups, medium shots, wide shots, sequence shots, etc. The training also addressed careful handling of information in terms of script writing. A story may look very straight forward, but there may be red flags that can be overlooked. This training helped upgrade the new reporter's skills in their current position as well as future career opportunities.

Provided training to management level personnel on methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and prevent discrimination

(a) As required by California law, all KTSF all staff are provided training on Sexual Harassment and Abusive Conduct Prevention. The training is ongoing as it's required every 2 years. It's 2 hours of training for management and 1 hour for non-management. The training is available in Chinese for employees who prefer this language option. Certificates following completion are required and maintained by KTSF.

- (a) On the Jobs page of our KTSF website, we invite all organizations, in the San Francisco Bay Area to be part of our mailing list for job availabilities. In 2022 (Jan-May,) KTSF had an average of 33,620 monthly viewers to our website. This notice appears in both English and Chinese.
- (b) On the Jobs page of our KTSF website, we also encourage visitors to consider a career in television with this posting that is in both English and Chinese:

Have you considered a career at KTSF televisions?

Are you looking for an employer where you can apply and grow your skills in Broadcasting and Digital Media? KTSF is a great place to apply the job skills you may have and, more importantly, expand on them with excellent training and mentorship that KTSF staff provides. Over the years, staff have been promoted to higher positions in departments including news, production and operations. If you haven't considered a career in broadcasting or online media, take a closer look at KTSF.

e) Encouraged staff referrals on an on-going basis through staff emails and virtual meetings. During this reporting period, this resulted in at least (4) applicants to full-time job openings that may not have otherwise know about the positions.
